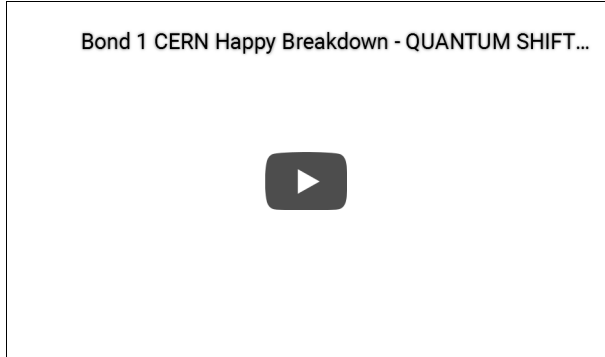

In the first verse of that chapter the serpent asked Eve, "hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden?". Eve obviously knew the correct answer to the question, but the serpent wasn't asking because he actually wanted to know the answer. This was just a deceptive tactic to put into Eve's mind some question like "Did God really say something like that or do I remember him saying something else?" Throughout that entire event the serpent never actually changed God's word. I'm sure he would have liked to, but he didn't have the power to literally rewrite God's word, so instead he just deceived Eve about the issue. He didn't have the power to alter the word of God, but he did have the power to confuse Eve about the word of God and get her to doubt whether God really said what He said.

Eve may seem incredibly naive for letting the enemy cause her to question what she obviously knew God said, but she's really no more foolish than a lot of modern people. Today we have people looking right at the type on the pages of the Bible, and asking the question, "Was that really what my Bible originally said? Did God really say that?" It's the same deceptive question that the serpent put into Eve's mind. The serpent who has never had the power to rewrite the word of God has always had the power to confuse naive humans about the word of God.

Now is it really that difficult to see what the real deception here is?

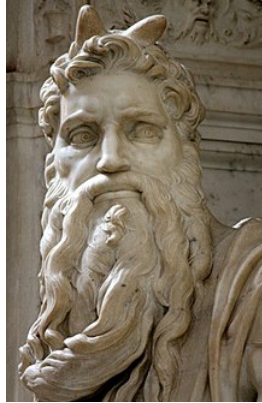

That last one at least is due to a translation error. There is a statue of Moses that has horns, it was translated from when Moses came down from being in the presence of God.

[Exodus 34](#) reads: 29 And it came to pass, when Moses came down from mount Sinai with the two tables of testimony in Moses' hand, when he came down from the mount, that Moses wist not that the skin of his face shone while he talked with

him.

That is the KJV but the Latin Vulgate and other translations read:

29 And when Moses came down from the mount Sinai, he held the two tables of the testimony, and he knew not that his face was horned from the conversation of the Lord.

It was mistranslated, a misunderstanding of the Hebrew word קָרַן which actually means to emit rays.

It wasn't just putting the doubt in her mind:

2 And the woman said to the serpent, "We may eat of the fruit of the trees of the garden; 3 but of the fruit of the tree which *is* in the midst of the garden, God has said, 'You shall not eat it, nor shall you touch it, **lest you die.**' "

Barring the fact the Eve herself actually added to his word by saying this:"nor shall you touch it" we find the adversary counters what God actually did say with this:

4 Then the serpent said to the woman, "**You will not surely die.** 5 For God knows that in the day you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil."

Let's go back to chapter 2 and see what God actually said, to Adam, before Eve.

15 Then the Lord God took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to tend and keep it. 16 And **the Lord God commanded the man**, saying, "Of every tree of the garden you may freely eat; 17 but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die."

So basically

**God said (actually commanded):** 'If you eat of the tree of the K of G&E you will surely die'

**Eve says:** 'If you eat it or touch it you will surely die'

**Serpent says:** ' You will **NOT** surely die'

In the text of Gen 2 & Gen 3 there is no indication that the serpent literally caused a change to God's word.

If you mean that he contradicted God's word or lied about God's word then I certainly agree. If you mean that he confused Eve about God's word then the text may support that. If you mean that he convinced Eve to violate God's word that's clearly true. But nowhere in the text is there any indication that he literally changed what God said.

It's not as if he had some magic power to alter reality, or some time-machine so that he could go back in time and gag God to stop Him from speaking. As you pointed out the command that God gave is still recorded in Gen 2:16-17 despite all the enemy's lies. Perhaps the enemy would like to make those verses magically vanish from the Bible, but they're still there after all these centuries because he can't. I'm sure he would love to overwrite the entire crucifixion and resurrection of Christ most of all, but he doesn't have that power. If he cannot alter what has happened, then he resorts to his next best option: lie about what has happened.

The serpent **did not actually change** Gods word. The very first commandment he got them to break because he **lied about** what God said.

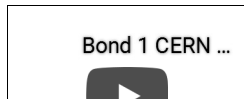

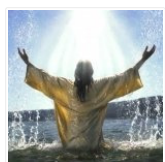

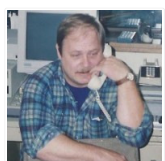
