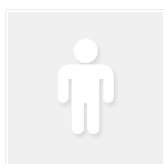

*1 In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.*

The Hebrew word translated by the King James Version translators, "heaven" in [Genesis 1:1](#) is the word "Ha Shamayim" the suffix 'im' indicates the word is meant to be plural.

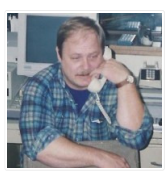
