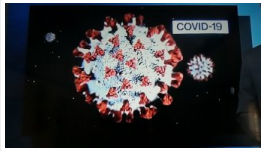

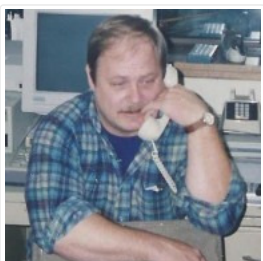

So weather it's a KJV published in 2020, or a copy of a 1611, the changes are universal. No matter the age of the bible.

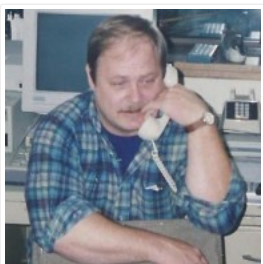

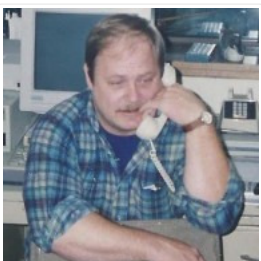
