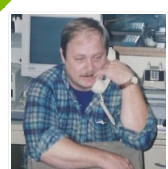

Clear as day.

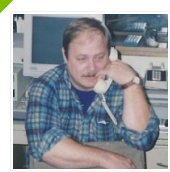

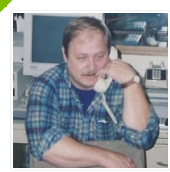

I remember being taught about "wineskins". But that word isn't in the KJV, and I'm told it never was.

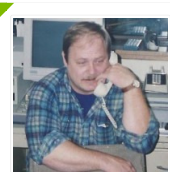
If it was never there, how in the world do I have memories of it? When I read the word "bottles" now, it just seems wrong.
